

# SOUTHWEST CATTLE CLASH RULES

July 24-25, 2020

APEX Center, Wytheville, VA

CATTLE ENTRY FEE: \$25.00 per head

(entry fee includes entry in both rings and showmanship and cost of a t-shirt)

ENTRIES DUE: July 17, 2020

Late Registration: \$30 until day of show (no guarantee of t-shirt availability)

## GENERAL RULES

Southwest Cattle Clash is open to junior exhibitors of the beef breeds and crosses within the age limits set forth for exhibitors and animals. SCC Participants must have reached their 6th birthday and must have not reached their 22nd birthday prior to January 1, 2020.

The show is for weaned heifers. NO mother cows or nurse cows will be allowed on the Show Grounds.

Individual breeds will be responsible for conducting their show's rules, regulations, and show classification.

Mulch will be provided in the stalling barn.

Tie-Out space will be in the designated location. Tack space will be provided. 1 space per head of cattle.

**You must check-in cattle and exhibitors during these times:**

**Friday, July 24, 12:00 PM-4:00 PM**

The Virginia Junior Simmental Association, The APEX Center and/or the members of the Southwest Cattle Clash committee will NOT be responsible for injuries or damage to animals, equipment, or persons while attending Southwest Cattle Clash.

No one with a fever or symptoms of COVID-19, or known exposure to a COVID-19 case in the prior 14 days, is permitted in the establishment. Persons with symptoms should stay home until CDC criteria for ending isolation have been met.

Spectators and guests should stay at home. Immediate family members are only allowed on the show grounds and in the Show Ring area. All efforts are being made to live stream the show for those that cannot join us.

**All out of state cattle must be accompanied by an official health certificate as stated in health regulations.**

**HEALTH REGULATIONS FOR OUT OF STATE CATTLE EXHIBITED AT THE SOUTHWEST  
CATTLE CLASH**

**ALL OUT OF STATE CATTLE MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN OFFICIAL HEALTH  
CERTIFICATE SIGNED BY AN ACCREDITED VETERINARIAN OR AN APPROVED STATE OR  
FEDERALLY EMPLOYED VETERINARIAN.**

**HEIFER RULES**

ALL HEIFERS MUST BE CALVED ON OR AFTER SEPTEMBER 1, 2018.  
ANY BREEDS WITHOUT TEN HEAD ENTERED WILL BE PUT INTO THE AOB SHOW.  
HEIFERS CAN BE FITTED

**All Other Breeds:**

All Other breed classes are open to all duly recorded or registered animals that are not eligible for the breed shows provided.

Cattle eligible for exhibition in the "All Other Breed" show must be registered with a recognized breed association.

Registration papers must be presented at time of check-in. Any animal without registration papers will be placed in the commercial class.

**Angus:**

Animals must be registered with the American Angus Association.

Only purebred animals (100 %) are eligible to be shown.

Registration papers must be presented at the time of check-in. Any animal without registration papers will be placed in the commercial class.

**Belted Galloway:**

Animals must be registered with the US Belted Galloway Society.

Only purebred animals (100 %) are eligible to be shown.

Registration papers must accompany all animals

**Charolais:**

Animals must be registered with the American International Charolais Association.

Only purebred animals (100 %) are eligible to be shown.

Registration papers must accompany all animals

**Commercial:**

Open to any animal that is not eligible to be registered with a breed association or that is not accompanied with original registration papers.

**Gelbvieh:**

Animals must be registered with the American Gelbvieh Association.

Females must be 1/4 (25%) or higher to be eligible.

Registration papers must accompany all animals.

Hereford:

All animals must be registered with the American Hereford Association.  
Only purebred (horned or polled) animals (100 %) are eligible to be shown.  
Registration papers must accompany all animals.

Limousin:

The Limousin show is for heifers registered with the North American Limousin Foundation.  
Females must be 1/4 (25%) or higher to be eligible.  
Registration papers must accompany all animals.

Piedmontese:

Animals must be registered with the Piedmontese Association of the US  
Registration papers must accompany all animals.

Red Angus:

Animals must be registered with the Red Angus Association Herdbook.  
Heifers must be Category 1-A or 1-B. Must be 7/8 or higher to be eligible.  
Registration papers must accompany all animals.

Santa Gertrudis:

Animals must be registered with the Santa Gertrudis Breeders International.  
Registration papers must accompany all animals.

Shorthorn/Shorthorn Plus:

To show in the Shorthorn show the animals must be 50% Shorthorn blood concentration or higher and registered with The American Shorthorn Association. All heifers less than 50% will be shown in the AOB show.  
Registration papers must accompany all animals.

Simmental:

Animals must be registered with the American Simmental Association.  
Registration papers must accompany all animals.  
Only animals registered with the ASA and are at least  $\frac{7}{8}$  Simmental.

Percentage Simmental:

Animals must be registered with the American Simmental Association.  
Registration papers must accompany all animals.  
Only animals registered with the ASA and are at least  $\frac{1}{2}$  Simmental.

**STEER RULES**

Classes will be broken by weight only by discretion of SCC Committee  
Heath Requirements: See general rules.  
Steers can be fitted.

## **RULES FOR SHOWMANSHIP**

Open to all youth who are exhibitors in SCC.

Participants must exhibit the animal(s) entered in the exhibitors' name.

Judging is strictly on showmanship – no fitting. (Clipped, washed, and brushed only)

Classes will consist of at least 4 divisions that will show in the following order (ages as of day of show):

Senior (16-21)

Intermediate (13-15)

Junior (9-12)

Novice (6-8)
